## Family: Asilidae

**All Robber Flies have spiny legs and bristly faces. They are insectivorous, and they use their short, strong proboscis to pierce insects and inject them with neurotoxic and proteolytic enzymes. The enzymes paralyze the insect and turn their insides to goo, which the fly then sucks up through its proboscis.**
